WESTERN BLOT

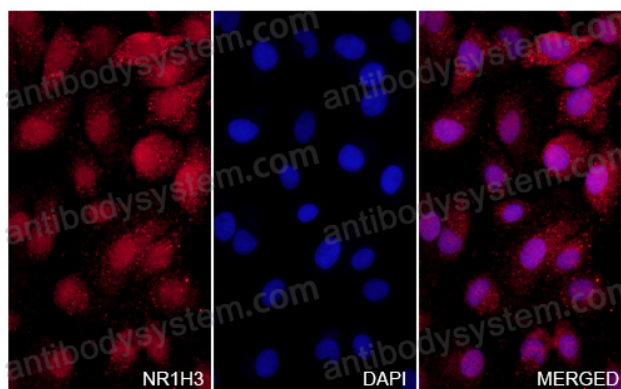
Recombinant Protein lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with NR1H3 antibody (PHG41701) at 1 μ g/ml.

Lane 1: Recombinant protein

Second Ab: Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L Polyclonal antibody, HRP (PTB96431) at 0.1 μ g/mL.

Predict MW: 41 kDa

Observed MW: 41 kDa



Immunocytochemistry/ Immunofluorescence

NR1H3 in HeLa Cell Line.

The HeLa cells were fixed with 4% paraformaldehyde (20 min), and then blocked with 5% goat serum for 1h. And the cells were incubated for 2h at 37°C with NR1H3 (PHG41701) at 3.7 μ g/ml. The section was then incubated with Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG (Alexa Fluor-594) preabsorbed at 1/100 dilution (Shown in red) for 1 hour at room temperature. Nuclear DNA was labelled with DAPI (shown in blue).
