<b>Alternative Names</b>	Tyrosine-protein kinase-defective receptor EPH-6, EPHB6, Ephrin type-B receptor 6, HEP
<b>Form</b>	Lyophilized
<b>Storage buffer</b>	Lyophilized from a solution in PBS pH 7.4, 5% Trehalose, 5% Mannitol.
<b>Purity</b>	>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE.
<b>Applications</b>	Bioactivity, ELISA, Immunogen, SDS-PAGE, WB
<b>Biological activity</b>	Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA. Immobilized rhEPHB6 (Cat #: AHA44601) at 2 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind rmEphrin-B2 with a linear range of 0.078-5.00 ng/mL.
<b>Endotoxin level</b>	<0.1 EU/µg of the protein by the LAL method.
<b>Expression system</b>	Mammalian Cells

<b>Protein length</b>	Val17-Thr579
<b>Nature</b>	Recombinant
<b>Stability and Storage</b>	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles. Store at 2 to 8°C for one week. Store at -20 to -80°C for twelve months from the date of receipt.
<b>Reconstitution</b>	Reconstitute in sterile water for a stock solution. A copy of datasheet will be provided with the products, please refer to it for details.
