Storage buffer	Lyophilized from a solution in PBS pH 7.4, 5% Trehalose, 5% Mannitol.
Purity	>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Applications	Bioactivity, ELISA, Immunogen, SDS-PAGE, WB
Biological activity	Measured by its ability to enhance anti-CD3-induced IFN gamma secretion of mouse CD3+ T cells. The ED50 for this effect is 0.5-2.5 µg/mL.
Endotoxin level	<0.1 EU/µg of the protein by the LAL method.
Expression system	Mammalian Cells

Protein length	Gln30-Trp248
Nature	Recombinant
Stability and Storage	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles. Store at 2 to 8°C for one week. Store at -20 to -80°C for twelve months from the date of receipt.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in sterile water for a stock solution. A copy of datasheet will be provided with the products, please refer to it for details.

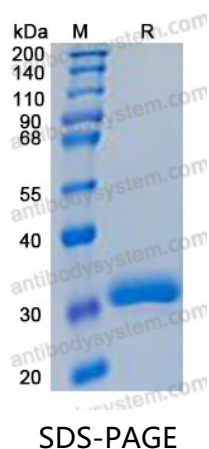
Shipping
