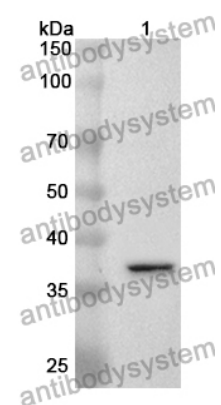

Stability and Storage	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles. Store at 2 to 8°C for frequent use. Store at -20 to -80°C for twelve months from the date of receipt.

WESTERN BLOT

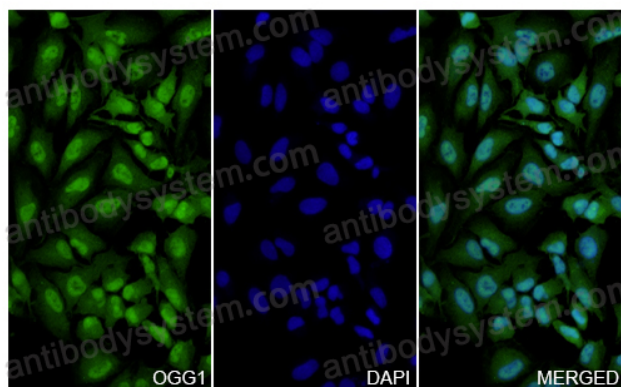
Recombinant Protein lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with OGG1 antibody (PHA56001) at 1 μ g/ml.

Lane 1: Recombinant protein

Second Ab: Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L Polyclonal antibody, HRP (PTB96431) at 0.1 μ g/mL.

Predict MW: 38 kDa

Observed MW: 38 kDa



Immunocytochemistry/ Immunofluorescence

OGG1 in HeLa Cell Line.

The HeLa cells were fixed with 4% paraformaldehyde (20 min), and then blocked with 5% goat serum for 1h. And the cells were incubated for 2h at 37°C with OGG1 (PHA56001) at 10 μ g/ml. The section was then incubated with Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG (Alexa Fluor-488) preabsorbed at 1/100 dilution (Shown in green) for 1 hour at room temperature. Nuclear DNA was labelled with DAPI (shown in blue).
